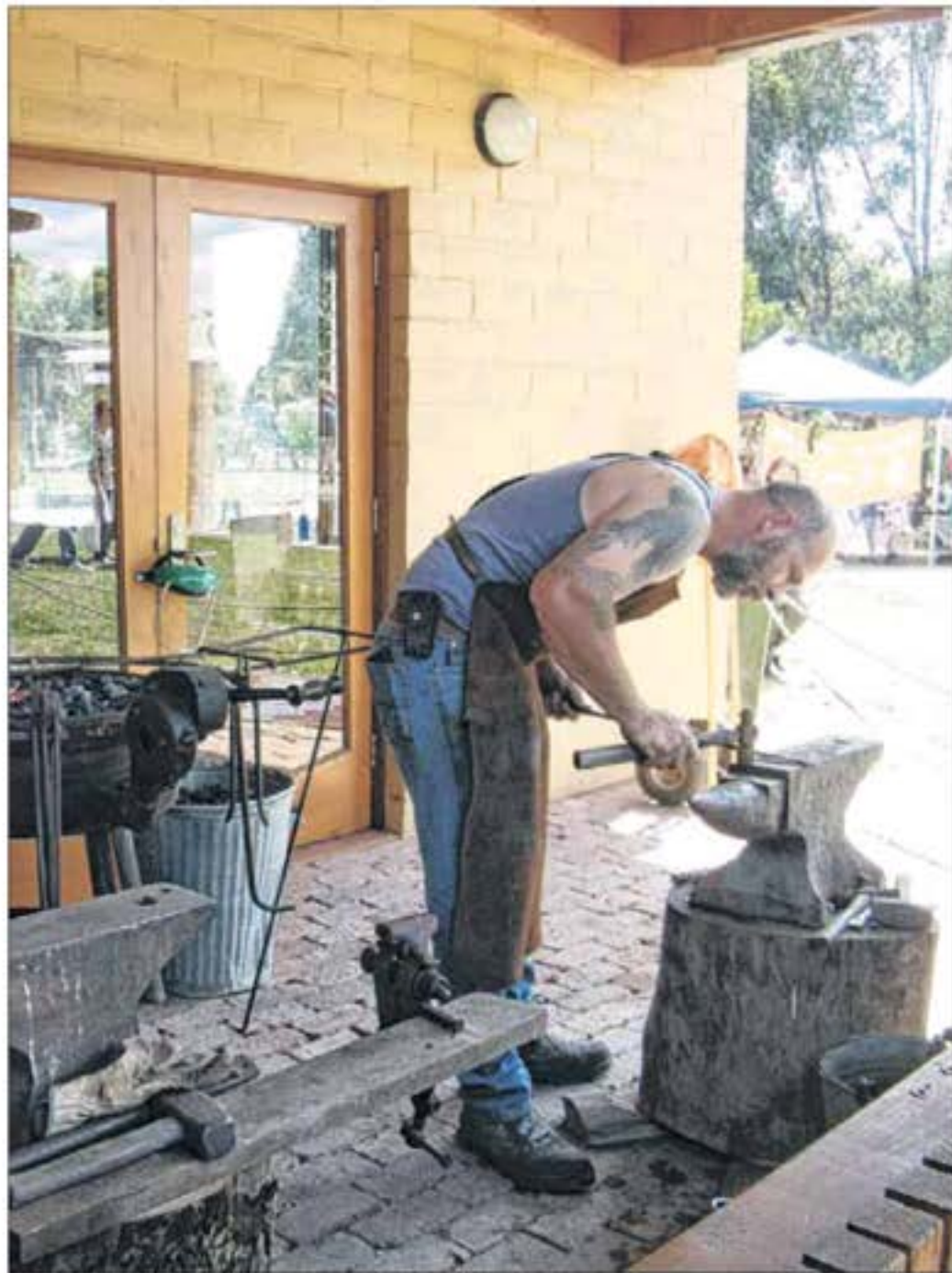


# Mansfield Steiner School celebrates 30 years at open day
