Mansfield Steiner School Academic Scholarships Conditions

General Information

1. Eligibility

Mansfield Steiner is coeducational and non-denominational Steiner School from Kindergarten to Year 9. With all scholarships awarded on the basis of Academic Merit and are open to Australian Citizens and Permanent Residents.

2. Academic Scholarships Available

Full Scholarships – One or more full scholarships will be offered, enabling students to complete their secondary education at our School without payment of any tuition fees.

Part Scholarships – Several part scholarships will be offered, which provide between 25% - 75% tuition fee remission for Years 7 to 12.

Duration of Scholarships – Each scholarship continues for the following academic year(unless the scholarship is cancelled).

3. Cancellation of Scholarships

A scholarship may be cancelled if:

- the recipients behaviour and/or progress is considered to be unsatisfactory
- the recipient is suspended or excluded from School
- the student leaves the School

4. Application for Scholarship

Applicants must apply using our Scholarship Form. Copies of the student's two most recent school reports along with a non-refundable application fee of \$20 (inc GST) must be included when submitting the application.

5. Application Closing Date

Scholarship applications will be accepted until close of business on Friday 4 August 2017. Interviews will follow from 18th August 2017.

6. Notification of Applicants Outcome

Successful applicants will be invited to attend a Scholarship Interview with the Principal. Scholarships will be awarded at the Principal's discretion as soon as possible following the interview. All applicants will receive notification as to the outcome of their application. Actual order of scholarships will not be reported, other than whether it is a Full or Part Scholarship.

7. Additional Information

Where possible the application form requires confirmation from two caregivers (often both biological parents) that the student is permitted to apply for the Academic Scholarship. We understand that in some families this may not be possible.
